In this role, you will assist with the measurement, layout, preparation, fabrication, installation, and repair of structural metal components and process piping systems. You will work alongside a skilled team of maintenance professionals, including four experienced welders, in a dynamic manufacturing environment.

1. **Skills Required:**

- Basic arithmetic skills, including addition, subtraction, multiplication, and measurement calculations.
- Ability to read, understand, and follow written instructions, drawings, and specifications.
- Knowledge of welding tools, fabrication equipment, and safe work practices.
- Mechanical aptitude and the ability to repair chemical process piping and equipment.
- Familiarity with metal fabrication and welding techniques.
- Ability to work weekends (at least 2 Maintenance Saturdays a month).

2. **Education and Experience Requirements:**

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Minimum of 3–5 years of welding experience.
- Technical or trade school training preferred.
- Letter of recommendation or documentation from a previous employer demonstrating welding experience and abilities is a plus.

3. **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Includes both structural steel and piping projects.
- Perform metal cutting, grinding, and fabrication activities using a variety of tools and equipment.
- Apply basic structural and pipe welding methods.
- Assist with the installation, maintenance, and repair of steam, air, water, and chemical piping systems and related equipment throughout the facility.
- Support the movement, installation, and rigging of equipment at various elevations throughout the plant.
- Maintain a safe work environment by complying with all company safety policies and procedures.
- Participate in company-wide quality, environmental, and health and safety initiatives in support of ISO 9001, ISO 14001, and ISO 45001 standards.
- Maintain a general understanding of ISO 9001, ISO 14001, and ISO 45001 requirements and support compliance efforts.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
